Provide a brief essay answering the following questions as part of our admission requirements into the TCU/IAM Advanced Transportation Training Program.

- 1. Why are you interested in TCU/IAM? (What is your career goal and how do you see TCU/IAM helping you with your career goals?)
- 2. In what area of the transportation industry would you like to establish your career? For example: Airline, Railroad (Passenger/Freight) or Barge Line
